


Students and educators: discover China! Sign up NOW for the trip of a lifetime.

World-famous historic and cultural sites

• Beijing

China's national capital for over 800 years, featuring the Forbidden City, Tiananmen Square, the Temple of Heaven, and the unforgettable Great Wall.

Chongqing

Home of Hot Pot and the Three Gorges Dam, Ciqikou Old Town and the Stilwell Museum.

• Chengdu

Home of the Giant Panda Center, picturesque Jinli Street and the world's largest statue of the Buddha.

• Shanghai

Center of technology and international trade, visit the Bund waterfront area and classic Yu Garden.

Real life with Chinese young people

Chinese education

Take advantage of a unique opportunity to spend 4 days in a Chongqing school, share learning projects with students, and hear about history and culture from their teachers.

Chinese daily life

Gain first-hand knowledge of typical Chinese life by enjoying activities arranged with the local community. Home stay may be possible.

Chinese food

Delicious local cuisine including hot pot and dumplings.

Cost of the trip: \$3,600 (includes air fare)

Includes round-trip international airfare to Beijing, hotel, meals, transportation within China, entertainment, tour guide, and international travel insurance. Visa application fee and personal expenses are not included. Minimum group size is 15.

Note: teachers are encouraged to apply for professional development funds for the trip.

How to participate

Oct. 31, 2018 Submit \$600 deposit and your registration form. The deposit is non-refundable unless the trip is cancelled by SPIRAL. Dec. 1, 2018 Final decision to schedule the trip will be made by SPIRAL. **Dec. 15, 2018** 50% of balance due (\$1,500).



Tickets will be bought shortly thereafter, after which only non-ticket costs may be refunded.

Feb. 15, 2019 Remaining balance due (\$1,500).

Refunds after this date will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis only.

Mar. 1, 2019 Visa applications with passports, photos and fees will be submitted to the Chinese Consulate.

Day 8	Chengdu	Travel to Chengdu by bullet train. After lunch, visit the Wide & Narrow Alley and Jinli Street.		Dinner and rest
Day 9	Chengdu	Spend the day exploring Le Shan Mountain and visiting the Giant Buddha statue.		Dinner and rest
Day 10	Chengdu	Visit the Panda Nursery	After lunch, fly to Shanghai	Dinner and rest
Day 11	Shanghai	Visit downtown Shanghai, Temple of the City, Yu Garden and the Bund.		Dinner and rest
