GOALS:

American educators will engage in advanced learning of Chinese culture, classic literature and arts through lectures/workshops taught by Chinese teachers and professors. These classes help U.S. Chinese teachers further enhance their knowledge and understanding of Chinese classics, and enable them to significantly enrich their classroom teaching back to home schools in the U.S. Furthermore, by observing the instruction of Chinese language and culture in the classrooms of China, communicating with Chinese teachers, and sharing educational approaches and best practice experiences, American teachers will learn from Chinese teachers specialized pedagogical and instructional strategies.

Another goal of this PD program is that U.S. Chinese teachers will gain firsthand experience of the cultural diversity and inclusivity in Guizhou, China where multi-ethnic groups, such as Miao, Buyi, Dong, and many more, harmoniously co-exist. Teachers from the U.S. will learn how the Han Chinese amicably integrated with the people of various ethnic minority groups, and how mainstream Han Chinese cultural traditions smoothly adopted and adapted by minority groups in the local communities. By so doing, they will deepen their understanding on how Chinese culture, through adoption and adaptation, takes root in different social climates and makes significant contributions to societal diversity, equity, justice and inclusion.

In addition, through the exchange, U.S. teachers have a chance to explore the opportunities to develop short-term service-learning programs for American students.
